Frequently asked Questions about Adult Day Services

Who do you serve?

We welcome any adult who needs supervision, socialization, and/or assistance with personal cares. Many of our guests have disabilities or dementia/Alzheimers.

Do you have any openings?

We have the capacity for 5 more full-time guests and several openings for part-time or drop-in guests.

What are your hours?

We are open Monday-Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. We follow the RCAS winter weather closures and are closed most major holidays.

How much does it cost?

Our private pay rate is \$25/hour. There are programs available through the Division of Long Term Services & Support that may be able to help cover the cost of your loved one's attendance. Veterans can often use their VA benefits to attend. We work with all of our guests to access available funding.

We are a 501(c)3 non-profit and rely on cash/in-kind donations in order to continue our services.

What can we expect?

We offer activities throughout the day that enhance cognitive and physical abilities, and create friendships and acceptance. We have a compassionate staff who can help with personal cares/showers if needed. Communication with caregivers is essential to ensure we are providing the best possible care for your loved ones.
